

Booking Terms and Conditions

(full details on website or on request)

1. We reserve the right to refuse any booking and/or to refuse entry on arrival if the unit or declared occupants do not match your booking, or to ask any customer to leave if they act unreasonably towards our staff or other guests. Fees will not be refundable unless the pitch can be re-let when a proportion of fees might be refunded.
2. Extra guests, cars, tents, etc., may be allowed when they do not exceed the pitch capacity and are pre-booked and paid at least 24 hours before arrival. Day visitors may be allowed, and they must register and pay at reception.
3. Bookings are only confirmed upon receipt of a non-refundable deposit of £40 per week. Balances are payable 7 days before arrival. Bookings will be cancelled without a refund of the deposit if the balance is not paid on time.
4. We can only take a limited number of group bookings. These must be declared at the time of booking. Please mention any possible friends or family additions when booking as we may not be able to add to your booking later and undeclared groups will be asked to leave. By groups, we mean people that you know and that you will spend time with while staying at the park – even if they make a separate booking.
5. All guests and visitors must agree to abide by the Responsible Visitor Pledge.
6. We will agree an arrival slot between 12 noon and 9 pm on your arrival day and you are asked to vacate by 11 am on the date of departure (unless earlier or later times have been agreed and confirmed on your booking).
7. Any property (including a caravan, motorvan or tent) left behind on departure will be considered abandoned and may be sold to cover storage fees unless storage arrangements have been made, paid and confirmed in writing.

Responsible Visitor Pledge.

For everyone's safety and enjoyment, we ask you to commit to:

1. Respect the safety, peace and privacy of our staff, our neighbours and other site users by:
 - Not using e-scooters on the park.
 - Staying at home if you (or anyone in your household) have even mild symptoms of a contagious illness.
 - Keeping noise to a minimum so that other campers are not disturbed, particularly after 10.30 pm.
 - Not entering or taking "shortcuts" through another customer's pitch.
 - Ensuring that all children (under 18) are always supervised by a responsible adult.
 - Sticking to our strict 5mph speed limit and always following public highway rules.
 - Not leaving your dog unattended and using a short lead (2m max), even in the dog walk areas, and not walking your dog over any camping areas (even if unoccupied). Pick up and bin all poo on the park and local walks.
2. Respect the wildlife and natural environment on and around the park by:
 - Avoiding disturbing the wildlife or neighbouring farm animals or crops by staying on designated paths, not picking any plants or flowers and keeping your dog(s) on a lead.
 - Using only gas or charcoal barbecues (no flames, fires or firepits) and keeping these raised off the grass (ask at reception to borrow a block).
 - Not using or launching drones, Chinese lanterns or fireworks from the site or surrounding area.
3. Living sustainably and supporting the local economy where you can by:
 - Recycling as much of your waste as possible (use our clear bags for mixed recycling).
 - Not using more water or electricity than necessary.
 - Consider a car-free day. Walk, take a bus or share a taxi. (See our transport guide at reception.)
 - Buying local, eating out and supporting local charities and events.

We reserve the right to make reasonable amendments to these terms without prior notice where necessary. Anyone not observing them or acting unreasonably will be asked to leave the park without a refund.

General cancellation policy

If you need to rearrange your holiday for any reason, then we will be pleased to help. Let us know a minimum of 24 hours before you are due to arrive and we will transfer your booking to a new date in the next 12 months or create a credit note that you can use in the next 12 months (T&Cs apply, please ask for details).
